Mission San Juan Capistrano

Located near South Coast Plaza, the Orange County Performing Arts Center is one of the nation's premier arts organizations. The Center offers the world's leading dance companies, Broadway shows, award-winning classical, jazz and cabaret artists, family entertainment, special events and year-round education programs. It is also the home of four Arts Partners, the Pacific Symphony, the Philharmonic Society of Orange County, Opera Pacific and Pacific Chorale. The center encompasses the 3000 seat opera house style Segerstrom Hall, the 2,000-seat Renée and Henry Segerstrom Concert Hall, the 500-seat multi-functional Samueli Theater, 250-seat Founders Hall and 46,000-square-foot community plaza.

Honda Center

Orange County Zoo

The Orange County Zoo is inside Irvine Park in the city of Orange. Nestled among 477 acres, the wilderness park exhibits animals and plants native to the Southwestern United States. The zoo offers educational programs and special events throughout the year.

Discovery Science Center

The Discovery Center of Springfield is an interactive, hands-on museum committed to inspiring people of all ages with a life-long love of learning and an appreciation of the world and our place in it. The DCS currently houses 60,000 square feet of interactive exhibit space. Exhibits and programs currently in place interweave a broad array of the hard sciences, technology, math, health, the environment, culture, art and communications. Specific traveling exhibits are brought in two to three times per year to keep the DCS environment fresh and exciting for visitors.

Crystal Cathedral

Located in Garden Grove, California, the Crystal Cathedral is the home base for the international Crystal Cathedral Ministries, including a congregation of over 10,000 members and the internationally televised "Hour of Power."

Dana Point Ocean Institute

The mission of the Ocean Institute is to inspire all generations, through education, to become responsible stewards of our oceans. The Ocean Institute has become nationally known for its hands-on marine science, environmental education and maritime history programs. More than 78,000 K-12 students and 6,000 teachers annually participate in the Institute's 61 award-winning, immersion style programs. To learn oceanography and science, students voyage onto the ocean to feel and taste the salty sea spray, sort through live specimens, observe migrating whales and collect scientific data. To learn maritime history and literature, students spend an entire night aboard the brig *Pilgrim* - each student hauling lines, hoisting sails, standing night watch and swabbing decks.

Balboa Amusement Center

Newport Beach's most famous landmark, the historic Balboa Pavilion, is one of California's last surviving examples of the great waterfront recreational pavilions from the turn of the century. Established 100 years ago in 1906 by the Newport Bay Investment Company, the Pavilion played a prominent role in the development of Newport Beach as a seaside recreation area. The Pavilion is a classic example of the turn-of-the-century waterfront pavilions and continues to be the center of Newport Beach activity. Currently, the Pavilion is used as a marine recreation facility, with sport fishing boats, a giant passenger catamaran to Catalina Island, harbor sightseeing cruises, boat (skiff) rentals, whale watching, and the new Harborside Restaurant and Grand Ballroom.

South Coast Plaza
